Welcome to the Los Angeles Air Force Base Child and Youth Program (CYP), whether it be the Child Development Center, School Age Program, or the Open Recreation Program, we are excited to take this new journey in your child(ren)'s development.

Child and Youth Programs assist DoD military and civilian personnel in balancing the competing demands of the accomplishment of the DoD mission and family life through delivery of a system of quality, available and affordable programs and services for eligible children and youth birth through 18 years of age. Note: CYP supports some special education students through their twenty-first birthday as they may be eligible for public education until that age.

To ensure your child(ren)'s enrollment is completed in a timely manner please review the items below for guidance:

- All families utilizing care must be enrolled into CYPBMS. Ensure to provide your program administrator with an accurate email to register your child(ren).
- Forms issued by the program must be reviewed and signed by the sponsor or designated guardian. If there are questions regarding any forms, please leave them blank and the program administrator will go over them with you.
- CYPBMS and all forms **MUST** be reviewed for completion before a program and classroom orientation can be scheduled. Incomplete steps will result in delay of care and/or the offer for care to be rescinded.

All guidance, policies, and procedures follow Department of Air Force Instruction 34-144 (Oct 2024) and NAEYC / COA. Contact your programs office with any questions or concerns.
