

Permission for Allergy/ Special Needs Posting

Allergies:

The Child Development Center posts the monthly allergy list in a centralized area located in the kitchen and each classroom to ensure children/youth are not exposed to foods or environmental contaminants that may be harmful to them (e.g. allergens). Parents must sign a statement of consent permitting the center to post their child/youth's allergy information (with or without pictures).

Medical Forms/ Documentation Provided by Child's Physician:

Children/youth who have been identified with a food allergy or who are otherwise intolerant to specific foods must be offered nutritionally equivalent substitutes. Documentation to include recommended food substitutions and an exposure response plan must be provided by the child/youth's health care provider and maintained on file.
