

Annual Permission for Topical Ointments

Items provided by CDC:

Sunscreen, insect repellent and hand sanitizer: Only sunscreens, insect repellents and hand sanitizers approved by the CYP Medical Advisor and purchased by CYP will be applied to children/youth. Any exception to the approved and purchased sunscreens, insect repellents and hand sanitizers must be accompanied with a detailed note signed by a health care provider, AF Form 1055 and updated annually.

Items provided by parents:

Hand lotions, lip balms, and non-prescribed diaper creams must be supplied by the parent/guardian and be clearly labeled with the child's first and last name.

A parent/guardian must sign annually to authorize the application of sunscreens, lip balms, hand lotions, non-prescribed diaper ointments/creams, insect repellents and hand sanitizers.
